In order to qualify for a payment plan, post-dated cheques or a Visa/Mastercard number must be provided by Registration Day. Payments can be made online or by phone via Visa/Mastercard. In person payments can be made with a Canadian or US cash/cheques, debit as well as Visa or Mastercard.

Detailed information regarding your charges will be made available on your personal populi Account.

Please indicate how you will be paying your student account. A Late Payment Fee of \$100 will be charged when a student fails to make a required payment.

- Two Pay Plan:** Total payment of your student account is divided into two equal payments. The first payment is due on Registration Day and the second payment is due on October 1.
- Three Pay Plan:** Total payment of your student account is divided into three equal payments. The first payment is due on Registration Day, and the remaining two payments are due on October 1 and November 1.
