## Kingswood University MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM

The Matching Grant Program offered by Kingswood University is a tangible and practical way for churches to assist students with the cost of their ministerial education. In doing so, we salute the partnership we share in raising up a new generation of spiritual leaders to serve the Church.

Kingswood University will match dollar for dollar, up to a maximum of \$500 (Canadian funds) per academic year, contributions from churches for any student a church wishes to sponsor.

## Matching Grant Criteria:

- Churches, districts or denominations are eligible to participate in the matching grant program.
- Funds contributed by such charitable organizations must not be from the parents or the student receiving the benefit.
- Payments or stipends for any services rendered by the student are not eligible for matching grants.
- This <u>form & funds</u> must be received by Kingswood University prior to January 31<sup>st</sup> of the applicable academic year.
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 after initial year of attendance.
